
## 18 STORIES MULTI-CHOICE QUIZ ANSWERS

In whose story is this mentioned? What wider theme could this illustrate? Norma & David Zwaig. It shows how Jewish people did war work and helped the country and the local communities where they settled.

- 2) One of the occupations mentioned frequently in the stories links to animals and is now much less common in the UK
- **C) Fur trade (Furrier)** Why do you think Jewish people were often involved in this activity? The trade was linked to the occupation of tailor, a common profession among Jewish people in their original countries. Animal fur was often used for making clothes and linings in Eastern European countries where winters were especially cold. Killing animals for their fur is nowadays no longer acceptable but the trade still goes on in many parts of the world.
- 3) Who has a connection with Bevis Marks Synagogue? (See the timeline)
- A) Darren Marks

What did he do to help this historic synagogue? He helped to restore some of the original furniture.
