B) A holocaust glossary - (not all the answers are in the exhibition- You may need to do some research).

- 1) Someone who agrees to help a refugee by supporting them financially once they have reached a place of safety. **FASCIST GUARANTOR TYRANT**
- 2) An extreme political ideology that promotes notions of racial purity, dictatorship and the brutal suppression of any opposition. **MATERIALISM CAPITALISM FASCISM**
- 3) A confined, crowded area of city where members of a minority group are forced to live. **SANCTUARY SUBURB GHETTO**
- 4) Also known as the November Pogrom or the 'Night of Broken Glass'. Attacks on Jewish homes, shops and synagogues by violent mobs on 9th November 1938
KRISTALLNACHT BLITZ SONDERKOMMANDO
- 5) Someone who leaves their homeland to escape persecution.
MIGRANT REFUGEE GUARANTOR
- 6) A place of shelter, safety and security where people are protected from threats such as discrimination, violence, bullying, harassment, persecution, arrest, torture and death. **GHETTO SANCTUARY SUBURB**
- 7) The deliberate, systematic mass murder of large numbers of people belonging to a particular ethnic group. **ATROCITY GENOCIDE DEPORTATION**
- 8) A barbaric act of cruelty or violence usually resulting in a large number of deaths.
GENOCIDE ATROCITY CONCENTRATION
- 9) Transporting someone, often to another country, usually by force and against their will.
EXPLOITATION DETENTION DEPORTATION
- 10) The Hebrew word for the Holocaust. It means 'catastrophe'
KETUBAH SHOAH MITZVAH
